** On holidays it is forbidden to create a new fire by striking a match, lighter, etc., but it is permissible to light from an existing flame burning since before the holiday, such as a gas pilot or candle.*

SELLING THE "CHAMETZ"

The Torah forbids a Jew to own any chametz (bread, cake, beer, etc.) during Passover, so we sell all chametz (left after the search and burning) to a non-Jew, with a rabbi acting as our agent.

The non-Jewish buyer gives a small deposit, and the balance becomes a guaranteed loan. The sale of chametz transaction is legally binding, but the buyer may return it and retrieve his deposit.

Place all chametz utensils in a specific room or closet(s) to be sold, sealed with tape or lock, until after Passover.
